## **GIFT AID: EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Under the Gift Aid scheme, any amount donated to a registered charity qualifies for tax relief provided you have paid tax (whether income tax or capital gains tax) at least equal to the amount of tax due to be recovered from the Inland Revenue. Tax at the basic rate can be recovered by FaRiG from the Inland Revenue. Basic rate tax is at 20%. If you are a higher rate tax-payer, you can recover the additional amount of tax *via* your tax return.
